

Top 5 Resources for Lawyer's Practice Materials

For Washington:

1. Washington Practice – Excellent starting point for most Washington research questions. Available in print or on Westlaw
2. Washington State Bar Association Deskbooks – Such as the Appellate Practice Deskbook, the Real Property Desk book and the Family Law Deskbook. Very practice oriented approach with discussion of how issues actually play out in “the real world.” Available in print or on Loislaw
3. Washington Lawyers Practice Manual – Originally called the Young Lawyer's Practice Manual – very helpful for attorneys just starting out. Walks you through a legal issue in a step by step manner. Great place to find forms. Available only in print.

Federal:

4. Wright and Miller Federal Practice and Procedure – Excellent starting point for federal questions involving federal rules of procedure.

Generally:

5. *Trial Practice Sets*: These sets do similar things but are good for walking you through the nuts and bolts of litigation. All are available in print or on Westlaw.
