

**(March 11, 1991):**  
 "[In 1961,] the Law School received information about possible Ford Foundation funding for an Asian Law program from faculty of the Far Eastern and Russian Institute [at UW]. Informal discussions among the law faculty, and with Dean George Neff Stevens indicated broad support for such a program. Professors Peck, Morris, and Johnson were especially enthusiastic... Various ideas were put forward for the thrust of the program ... [but] the key position [had to be] filled, with someone who was an outstanding scholar, a first rate teacher, with professional contacts and recognition in Japan, and fluent in Japanese... We were extremely fortunate to induce Dan Henderson to accept this new position..."
